The Exeter Cup attracted 52 golfers playing in two-man teams. The first day of competition was played in the better-ball-of-partners format. On day two, the first nine was played alternate stroke, with the back nine played as a scramble.

The Exeter Cup was about more than golf. Living up to their tradition of giving back to the community, the golfers and tournament sponsors raised \$1,700 for the Exeter Community Library. Since 2010, RCC golfers and sponsors have raised \$17,000 for the library.
