Reading Country Club Hall of Fame

Purpose

The Reading Country Hall of Fame honors the men and women whose achievements have helped further the success and reputation of Reading Country Club and who have supported golf in Berks County and beyond.

Hall of Fame members will be recognized for their passion as players and ambassadors of the game. They will be individuals whose actions help preserve and promote the spirit of golf as embodied in its ancient and honorable traditions.

Eligibility

RCC Hall of Fame members must be or have been active players or representatives of the game in Berks County. Nominees need not have been members at RCC, but their achievements must have contributed to the success of RCC and golf in Berks County. Non-golfers (such as, but not limited to, sponsors, sportswriters, course personnel) may also be considered for the RCC Hall of Fame if they contributed to the growth and success of golf at RCC and in Berks County.

Nominations should include factual and reliable information. Scrapbooks, newspaper clippings, photographs, personal memorabilia and other media that support the nomination are acceptable. Photo copies of supporting documents are preferred to the original documents.

Nominations

Nominations must be made using the Nomination Form. The nominations will be evaluated by the Hall of Fame Committee. The HOF Committee may contact the nominator for additional information, if appropriate. A nominated committee member will not participate in the review of his or her nomination; a replacement committee member may be selected to participate in the review. Committee members may make nominations.

Recognition

Hall of Fame members will be recognized on the RCC Hall of Fame web page and their names will be included in a display in the RCC golf shop. The number of individuals selected each year will be at the discretion of the Hall of Fame committee.

Presentation

Individuals will be inducted into the RCC Hall of Fame prior to the annual Heritage Tournament. A family member or other individual may accept the award on behalf of a new Hall member who is unable to attend the ceremony or who is deceased.
